TREOCAPA-LT (Long Term Follow-up)

An observational follow-up of TREOCAPA designed to assess long-term outcomes among survivors at 2 years corrected age. The study has been approved by the Local Ethics Committee of ULS Santa Maria, Hospital São Francisco Xavier (ULSLO), and Centro Materno-Infantil (ULS Santo António).

Target PT: 12 participants
